WHERE DO I GO FOR NEW SKATES?

With the recent closure of North Edge Ice Sports in Prince George, our options for acquiring new skates have become limited. Koops Bike shop carries mainly recreational skates, but has informed us that they are planning to bring in more styles suitable for competitive skaters.

If your skater requires new skates—whether they've outgrown their current pair or need a stiffer boot to match their skill level—please consult Coach Jenn or Coach Ferro before making a purchase. Our coaches can provide valuable insight into the type of skate or blade your skater will need and assist you in navigating the decision-making process when the time comes.

PGFSC Consignment

Don't forget about the PGFSC Consignment where you can drop off skating gear and attire that you no longer need, and can also browse our selection of used skates, dresses, club sweatshirts and more!



SKATE SHARPENING

Caring for your figure skates is essential, and this involves regular sharpening. The frequency of sharpening depends on how quickly the skater wears down the blade's edge, as well as individual preference. A common recommendation is to sharpen the skates every 20 to 30 hours of skating. If you have any questions about skate sharpening, feel free to contact us via the club's email address.
